Conditions of Entry:

1. All ponies entered must be registered with the ASPA
2. All exhibitors must be financial members of the ASPA
3. Separate entry form to be completed for each exhibitor
4. Include photocopies of registration papers (front & back). If entering Dual Registered classes please include a photocopy of that registration/Membership as well.
5. Child handler classes – a photocopy of birth certificate is to be included with your entries
6. Keep a record of the classes you have entered
7. Payment only via direct deposit to: Australian Saddle Pony Association
8. The committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore.
9. Entry fees \$15 per class. Entry fees will not be refunded
10. Entries close 30th September 2022 (NO late entries will be accepted)
11. Compulsory administration fee:\$20.00
12. All stable and camping enquiries to M Mitton (0427099819)
13. Australian Saddle Pony Association Saddlecloths are required to be worn at this show. **No saddlecloth – no start.** Saddlecloths can be pre-ordered with your entries and collected at the show. They are available in 2 sizes. Small(suggested for ne 12.2hh) and large (12.2hh and over)
14. All studs/exhibitor entries that add over \$300 , will get additional entries at \$10
15. Can email entries direct to aspa.victoria@ausequine.com , ASPA BSB 062588, Account: 10223108
16. All attendee lists with contact names and phone numbers must accompany entry and be updated on arrival to show.
17. All entries must be signed on the forms provided.
18. The lodging of any entry shall bind the exhibitor to the Conditions of Entry set out herein, and the signature of the exhibitor or his/her agent on the ASPA entry form shall be deemed acceptance of these conditions.
19. The AGE of horses is to be calculated AS AT 1st AUGUST
20. The Committee designated has the power, without assigning any reason, to:reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - a. prohibit the participation of any person or exhibit in any event
 - b. cancel any event or class, or combine or split any class or classes
 - c. alter the time at which any event or class is to take place
 - d. remove any exhibit or exhibitor from the showgrounds
 - e. transfer any exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another
21. If a horse dies on the ground then it is the responsibility of the owner to remove the horse.
22. If a rider falls off it is immediate disqualification from that class. If any injury occurs then disqualified for remaining classes.

23. If a horse is thought to be determined as unsound by judge/committee than said horse will be disqualified with no repercussion to the Judge of the committee. There will be no refund of remaining classes.
24. Drug testing may randomly occur.
25. The organisers shall not be responsible for the loss of, or any damage or injury occasioned to, any exhibitor or the property of any exhibitor.
26. The exhibitor enters entirely at his or her own risk. In case any exhibit, whilst on the grounds, shall be the cause of any injury or damage to any other exhibit or exhibitor, or the person or property of any member of the general public, the owner of such exhibit shall indemnify the ASPA, its officers and members, from and against all damage, injury or loss occasioned to any of them by the exhibitor or their agent.
27. Any person causing annoyance by loud comments on the decisions of the Judges, or unseemly conduct or insulting behaviour, will, after being cautioned by an ASPA Show Organising Committee member be expelled from the Showgrounds, and said person may forfeit any prize money or trophies gained.
28. Should any exhibit having gained a prize be disqualified, the next on the list of awards does not necessarily obtain the same prize. The Disputes Committee, with the advice of the Judge, will decide.
29. If entries exceed 20, then classes may be split.
30. If entries are below 3, then classes may be combined.
31. Horses may be asked to present measuring certificate.
32. Bump in time for camping/stabling: 1500, Bump out time 1600 hours
33. newcomer-not to have competed under saddle prior to the 1st January the year of the show.
34. Stallion/colts must be handled by competent adults / person 18 years and over.
35. Stallion/colt classes are separated from other sexes, if eligible for a championship against Mare/gelding then need to be kept a distance and directed by Judge/steward. Only allowed to compete in specified classes.
36. Any unruly horse may be asked to leave the ring.
37. The judges decision is final subject to all other conditions being met.
38. No horse/pony is to be ridden bare-back, must be saddled. All riders must be wearing an approved helmet whilst mounted.
39. All vehicle's must only be going speeds of 15km on showgrounds.
40. All electric leads must be compliant and tagged by an electrician
41. No Horses to be tied to floats or objects and left unattended

LIABILITY WAIVER FORM

EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN RIGHTS TO SUE

HORSE RIDING IS A DANGEROUS ACTIVITY:

The purpose of this agreement is to limit the liability of the Provider to exclude liability for any personal injury or death to the Participant and other people in the care and control of the Participant howsoever caused who signed this form as acknowledgment of the terms and conditions of this agreement. By signing this form you are waiving your rights to sue the Provider for losses relating to personal injury or death. Under the provisions of the Trade Practices Act and Various

State Laws conditions are implied into contracts that mean that the Provider of Recreational Services, noted below, is required to ensure that the Recreational Services it sells to you are: rendered with due care and skill, are fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances or might reasonably be expected to achieve the result you have made known to the Provider.

Name and address of Provider: Australian Saddle Pony Association Victorian State Championships,

Name and address of venue: Tatura Equestrian Centre.

The Participant acknowledges that the activity being undertaken is an activity being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure which involves a significant degree of physical risk and or death. The Provider acknowledges that they are providing Recreational Services detailed below which means; providing facilities for participation in a recreational activity, or training a person to participate in a recreational activity, or supervising, adjudicating, guiding or otherwise assisting a person's participation in a recreational activity.

The Participant hereby acknowledges that in attending the recreational activity that there are inherent risks involved to him or her or other people in their care and control. This agreement is directed and limited to inherent risks that are patent. The Participant also acknowledges that the purpose of the recreational activity is for the benefit of the Participant and for the benefit of those people attending with the Participant and that at all times the Participant is responsible for his or her own actions and the actions of those other people in his or her care and control.

Description of Recreational Services: Horse riding, Showing, horse handling on the ground and horses being judged. Steps taken Provider to avoid the danger of personal injury or death: Regular equipment and facility inspections.

The Participant acknowledges that during all times while he or she is attending the recreational activity he or she does so at his or her own risk and that the Participant and other people in the care and control of the Participant will not hold the Provider or Venue and any of its employees, volunteers or agents liable for any personal injury and or death or breach of contract whether caused by the negligence of the Provider howsoever caused or otherwise. The Participant acknowledges that in the event that he or she or any of the other people in their care and control find either or any of them is in difficulty that they are to stop the activity or request that the activity be stopped if appropriate, and seek help and/or assistance and advice.

Declaration and signature By signing this agreement I understand that the Recreational Services about to be sold to me as set out in this form may

cause my and or my dependants personal injury or death. By signing this agreement I understand that I and my dependants waive our rights to sue the Provider for losses relating to my and or my dependants personal injury or death that result from any negligence caused by the Provider.

HORSE RIDING IS A DANGEROUS ACTIVITY

Release and Waiver of Liability

I understand and acknowledge that horse riding is a dangerous activity and that horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt. Any horse can bite, buck, kick, rear, startle, trip or slip, etc. and put the rider or handler at risk of injury or death.

I understand and acknowledge that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from horse riding, whilst on the ground around horses, handling horses and in lessons, clinics, training days.

I AGREE that I WILL RIDE, HANDLE AND BE AROUND A HORSE OR HORSES at my OWN RISK and that the event organiser and providers, venue owner, volunteers or agents shall not be liable for my personal injury, death, loss or damage occasioned to me or any loss or damage occasioned to any of my possessions whether such liability arises out of any express or implied term of my riding in

ANY rides, lessons, horse handling, whilst around horses on the ground, or at common law or in any other way.

OBLIGATIONS: I AGREE:

To not drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any riding, lesson, horse handling.

To immediately report to the Operators any injury to myself, my horse during any ride/lesson/when handling and the manner of the occurrence of such injury;

To immediately advise the Operators of any loss or damage to any horse tack, equipment, saddle, bridle and/or any other equipment owned by me or provided to borrow for my use during any ride/lesson/handling;

To wear a current approved horse riding helmet that is less than 5 years old during any ride.

CONDUCT: I AGREE:

To control myself and my during any ride/competition/handling in a proper and reasonable manner and, in particular, to ride the horse in a proper and horseperson like manner;

To be responsible for the well-being and safety of my during any ride/competition/handling on the ground and to not permit any other person to ride or handle that horse without the Operators prior permission;

To pay due regard to the safety of all other riders and persons involved in any ride/competition/handling;

To follow the directions of the operators and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of the operators will result in the CANCELLATION of my riding and my immediate removal from any horse/ride/handling NO MATTER where that may occur.

I agree to abide by all rules listed in the program.

Effect of This Document I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Operators to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering property damage, injury or death.
